



- 1. Pray the Apostles' Creed.
- **2.** Pray the Our Father.
- 3. Pray three Hail Marys.
- 4. Pray the Glory Be.
- **5.** Announce the First Mystery and pray the Our Father.
- **6.** Pray ten Hail Marys while meditating on the mystery.
- 7. Pray the Glory Be.
- 8. Pray the Fatima Decade Prayer.
- **9.** Announce the Second Mystery then pray the Our Father.
- **10.** Repeat numbers 6 8 and continue with the **3**rd, **4**th and **5**th mystery.
- 11. Conclude with the Hail Holy Queen.


First Joyful Mystery


Third Joyful Mystery


The Birth of Jesus in Bethlehem

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)








Fourth Joyful Mystery The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple




First Luminous Mystery





Second Luminous Mystery

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)









Third Luminous Mystery




Fourth Luminous Mystery

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)








Fifth Luminous Mystery








First Sorrowful Mystery

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)









Second Sorrowful Mystery **The Scourging at the Pillar**

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)








Third Sorrowful Mystery The Crowning with Thorns

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)








Fourth Sorrowful Mystery

(Pray one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be and the Fatima Decade Prayer)






The Resurrection of Jesus


O IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY, I love you! And I wait patiently for the day that your Immaculate Heart will triumph.

The Golden Prayer THE ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY







The Streaming Rays of Light signify the triumph of the Virgin Mary's Immaculate Heart in the world and at the hour of a consecrated soul's death.



The **Golden Initial** of the prayer, signifies that when a soul practices its personal consecration, the prayer becomes as precious as gold in the eyes of the Virgin Mary.



The Golden Border surrounding the image and prayer signifies the protection the Virgin Mary grants to her children devoted to her Immaculate Heart. The Gold Line surrounds spiritually all consecrated souls, making it impossible for the desires of worldly things and the forces of evil to lead them astray.



For Those Who Recite This Prayer Daily

The entire image and prayer reflect the Virgin Mary's purity, a virtue she wants all her children to practice. Since our Mother is the Queen of Purity, every offense committed against this virtue hurts her Heart in a cruel and painful way. Souls devoted to her Immaculate Heart should openly state that *only the pure of heart shall be close to God*.


